- 1. Answer any *one* of the following questions:
 - (a) Examine the concepts of Karma and its interconnection with Dharma in the Indian epic tradition. Use specific illustrations from either the Ramayana or the Mahabharata to demonstrate how Karma operates within the framework of Dharma, shaping the lives and destinies of characters.

- (b) Discuss the relationship between Rasa and Alankara in Sanskrit literature. Analyse how Alankara is employed to convey and intensify Rasa with reference to Kalidasa's work.
- (c) Evaluate the significance of the Neo-Vaishnavite Movement in Assam, led by Sankardeva. Describe how the movement shaped Assamese identity, culture and literature, highlighting its enduring legacy.

(b) What is the significance of the title Mrichchhakatika?
